

## 2011 Nonprofit Leadership Certificate Program Evaluation Report Evaluation Feedback Analysis

At the end of each day, Certificate Program participants received an evaluation form and were asked to provide feedback on the program. The following analysis is a result of the 19 Executive Leaders and 20 Emerging Leaders completed and partially completed evaluation forms. The results are separated by executive (Ex) and emerging leader (Em) tracks. Participants rated the Presenters and the Panel based on his/her content, format, and 'helpful to current or future role as a nonprofit leader' using the following scale: excellent, good, fair, or poor.

### Rankings and Open-Ended Responses by Presenter:

**The Strategic Board, Mark Light, PhD, First Light Group LLC** – One hundred percent of executive and emerging leaders ranked Mark's presentation as good or excellent. Both tracks praised his presentation and said that Mark is an energetic and informative presenter. Executives and emerging leaders valued his interactive format and called it "infotaining." Participants stated that the content was a great take away and provided practical application for real-world use.
